## Benefits of Music Coordinator/Director of Parish Music

- Enriches and enhances worship and the proclamation of the Word
- Closer integration of musical selections with themes and readings
- Promotes and supports musical "excellence" in worship, greater variety
- Increases use of musical gifts and talents of congregation members
- Redistributes duties (from Pastors/classroom teachers) to those with special musical gifts and/or training
- Encourages and trains future generations of church musicians
- Etc, etc, etc...

## What does this position look like?

- Hired or called? Yes :-)
  - But, imagine the benefits of a synodically trained musician/educator/staff minister knowledgeable in the history of and the "how-to's" of Lutheran worship! This can provide assurance to Pastors and create a relationship of trust that allows the Pastoral staff to "hand-off" or share planning aspects.
- Is it a part-time position or can it be? DEPENDS
  - Please carefully prioritize duties and ministry needs, build in/request practice time if you want them playing for services, account for "unseen hours" of planning, researching, selecting music, does it include school music or just the church and worship music?
- Is there enough to justify a full-time position?
  - YES. YES. YES. (See bullet point above and the following slides.)

#### **Main Church Duties**

- Meet with Pastor weekly to discuss worship details and music selections
- Direct Adult Bells, Adult Choir
- Children's Christmas Service (select/edit/rehearse/direct)
- Coordinate Accompanists (solos, school groups, choir)
- Sunday School Music (select music, rehearse, direct)
- Soloists/Small Groups (select music, rehearse, direct or accompany)
- Church Instrumentalists (select music, lead rehearsals)
- Advent by Candlelight Music
- VBS Music
- Create singing and bell schedule, hymnology schedule, organist schedule
- Organist as needed

#### **Additional Church Duties**

- Handbell Cleaning/Repair
- Schedule Piano Tunings & Organ Repairs
- Arrange organist or soloists for weddings/funerals
- Coordinate Special Music Groups (WISCO, Koine, Branches, etc)
- Music Texts/Cong Instructions/Copyrights to Pastor for Bulletin
- Submit for Organ Renumerations
- Order Music & Keep Records
- Manage Music Budget
- Maintain Music Storage and Filing
- Organize & maintain equipment
- Microphones, sound board, and other set-up

#### **CTL School Duties**

- Teach general music classes for Grades 1-8
- Direct 7-8th Junior Bells (2 choirs)
- Direct School Musical/Prism Jr Concert/Plays (3-year cycle)
- Children's Christmas Eve Service--select, edit, rehearse, direct
- Plan and chaperone MSO or other music field trips
- Schedule, select music, and rehearse all classroom singing for church
- Hymnology Schedule
- Music Grades to teachers for report cards

#### Additional music programs:

- WISCO Band Lessons,
- Piano Program (grades 2-8, Pastor's wife)

- Opening/Music for our Sunday JAM (Jesus and Me) program
- VBS Opening/Music
- Track and Submit information for Licenses

- Schedule Maintenance for Musical Equipment
- Add Worship Education Notes into the Bulletin
- Plan Worship Committee meetings with Pastor

- Oversee the Worship Ministry Team, Ushers, Altar/Worship Arts Team, Sunday Fellowship Team, Communion Assistants, Musicians

- Find volunteers
- Work with non-music volunteers: Music Librarian, Sound guy, Videographers, Altar/Worship Arts people, etc.
- Find, suggest, implement new music and liturgical elements
- Accompany for school music when needed
