"He trusts in the LORD; let the LORD res - cue him.


Let him deliver him, since he de - lights in him."

Refrain: Behold the Lamb, behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world.


My strength is dried up, and my tongue sticks to the roof of my mouth;




you lay me in the dust of death.




A band of evil men has encircled me, they have pierced my hands and my feet.




They divide my garments among them and cast lots for my clothing.
