O LORD, open my lips, and my mouth will de - clare your praise.


Save me from bloodguilt, O God, the God who saves me, and my tongue will sing of your right-eous - ness.

You do not delight in sacrifice, or I would bring it; you do not take pleasure in burnt of - fer - ings.


The sacrifices of God are a bro - ken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not de - spise.

**Refrain: Come, Holy Spirit, God and Lord, be all your graces now outpoured!**


Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spir - it with - in me.




Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spir-it from me.




Restore to me the joy of your sal - va - tion and grant me a willing spir - it, to sus - tain me.
