
Refrain: Not unto us, O Lord, but to your name be the glory.




Not unto us, O LORD, not unto us but to your name be the glory, because of your love and faith - ful - ness.



Why do the nations say, "Where is their God?" Our God is in heaven, he does what - ev - er pleas - es him.




The LORD remembers us and will bless us; he will bless the house of Is - ra - el,




he will bless those who fear the LORD, small and great a - like.






May you be blessed by the LORD, the Mak- er of heaven and earth.




The highest heavens be - long to the LORD, but the earth he has given to man.
