
Refrain: We commit ourselves to you, O Lord. Your faithfulness endures forever.

for like the grass they will soon with - er, like green plants they will soon die a - way.


Refrain: We commit ourselves to you, O Lord. Your faithfulness endures forever.

He will make your righteousness shine like the dawn, the justice of your cause like the noon-day sun.


Refrain: We commit ourselves to you, O Lord. Your faithfulness endures forever.




I was young and now I am old, yet I have never seen the righteous forsaken or their children begging bread.




Turn from evil and do good; then you will dwell in the land forever.




For the LORD loves the just and will not forsake his faithful ones.
