the ma - ker of heav'n and earth.



The Lord gives food to the hun - gry, the Lord sets pris - oners free.


The Lord gives sight to the blind,




the Lord lifts up those who are bowed down.




The Lord watches over the out - cast




and sustains the father - less and the wid - ow.




The Lord remains faithful for - ev - er.
