Refrain: At the works of your hands, O Lord, I lift up my voice in song; I sing for joy.



weeping may re - main for a night, but rejoicing comes in the morn - ing.


Refrain: At the works of your hands, O Lord, I lift up my voice in song; I sing for joy.




To you, O Lord, I called; to the Lord I cried for mer - cy.
