#### WELCOME TO TRINITY

Good morning and welcome to worship! We are happy to have you here worshiping with us this Palm Sunday. Our prayer is that God's Word might go with you as you begin to celebrate this holiest week in the Christian Church year. Please come again to worship with us here at Trinity often this Holy Week.

"Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord." Palm branches are strewn before the Lord of life with this accolade of praise. Yet this parade is merely a divinely orchestrated event leading to Jesus' gruesome death. But this holy death inspires an even louder confession: Jesus is Lord! This confession resonates throughout the Church, as Christians bear witness to Christ's endurance as He is mocked, persecuted, betrayed, and slain.

Stand and face the back of church as the bells begin to ring.


#### PALM SUNDAY PROCESSION







Philippians 2:5-11

Jesus humbled himself, yet is exalted as Lord of all

<sup>5</sup>Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: <sup>6</sup>Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, <sup>7</sup>but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. <sup>8</sup>And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death---even death on a cross! <sup>9</sup>Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, <sup>10</sup>that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup>and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem

¹As they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two of his disciples, ²saying to them, "Go to the village ahead of you, and just as you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, which no one has ever ridden. Untie it and bring it here. ³If anyone asks you, 'Why are you doing this?' tell him, 'The Lord needs it and will send it back here shortly.' " ⁴They went and found a colt outside in the street, tied at a doorway. 


