






after *Christ lag in Todesbanden*




L: The LORD is my strength and my song; he has become my sal - va - tion.




The LORD'S right hand is lift-ed high; the LORD'S right hand has done might - y things!

The stone the builders rejected has become the cap - stone;




the LORD has done this, and it is mar - vel - ous in our eyes.
