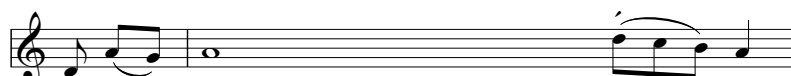


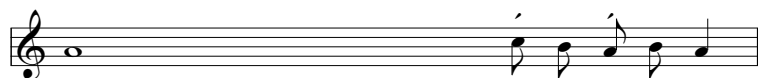
# Psalm 143
