





Taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed are they who take refuge in him.




The eyes of the LORD are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their cry.




The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear him, and he delivers them.

The righteous cry out, and the LORD hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles.




The LORD is close to the broken hearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.




The LORD re - deems his ser - vants; no one who takes refuge in him_ will be con-demned.
