



after *Was mein Gott will*




L: He who dwells in the shelter of the Most\_ High will rest in the shadow of the Al - might-y.

C: You\_ will not fear the ter-ror of the night, nor the arrow that flies\_ by\_ day.




If you make the Most High your dwell - ing,
